Ensure consistency and fairness in implementing school policy
Provide safe and supportive learning environments
Initiate and maintain constructive communication with students, parents and carers
Build and nurture positive relationships with students, parents and carers
Promote self reliance and management skills with students
Comply with mandatory guidelines

Unacceptable behaviour in our school:

Physical or verbal abuse
Unauthorised removal of school property
Vandalism or wilful damage
Trespassing
Intimidation or threatening behaviour
Possession, or being under the influence of alcohol
Smoking
Inappropriate language (swearing)
Obscene or offensive acts.
